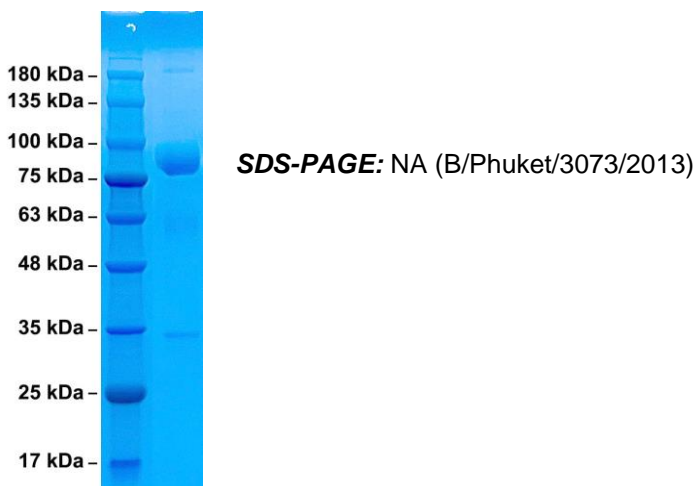

Introduction	Influenza virus neuraminidase (NA) is a type of virus membrane surface neuraminidase that enables the virus to be released from the host cell. Neuraminidase enzymes are glycoside hydrolase enzymes that cleave sialic acid groups from glycoproteins and are required for influenza virus replication.
Applications	Western blot standard, antibody ELISA, antigen, etc.
Description	Recombinant viral protein expressed and purified from HEK-293 cells C-terminal Fc-tagged neuraminidase (aa 37-466)(B/Phuket/3073/2013) (GISAID accession#: EPI1649071); molecular weight ~ 90 kDa.
Storage	Store at -20 °C. Non-hazardous. No MSDS required.
Concentration	1 µg/µl in PBS
Endotoxin Level	<0.01 EU per 1 µg of the protein by LAL test
Purity	>95% pure by 4-20% SDS PAGE gel
