

Gag (HIV-1/Clade A)

Introduction Gag (group-specific antigen), also called precursor gag polyprotein, is the main structural protein

of HIV-1. This precursor gag polyprotein is processed by viral protease during maturation to MA (matrix protein, p17); CA (capsid protein, p24); SP1 (spacer peptide 1, p2); NC (nucleocapsid

protein, p7); SP2 (spacer peptide 2, p1) and P6 protein.

Applications Western blot standard, antibody ELISA, HIV-1 entry inhibition, etc.

Description Gag protein expressed and purified from *E.coli*

Viral Protein C-terminal 6xhis tagged HIV-1 Gag (Clade A) protein (Genebank No. AY772985)

Storage Store at -20 °C; Stable for 3-months from the date of shipment when kept at 4 °C. Non-

hazardous. No MSDS required.

Concentration 1 mg/ml (50 mM Phosphate buffer, pH 7.4, 0.5M NaCl, 0.2M Imidazole, 8M Urea)

Specificity ≥ 90% purity (SDS PAGE).
